### TIPS FROM THE PRO

#### Driving your way to a better game.

David Talaba, Golf Professional at Littleton Golf and Tennis Club

A lot of golfers seem to think that the driver is THE most important club to use while practicing. While getting familiar with your driver is important, practicing with their irons allows players to irons to create and maintain a rhythmic, repeatable swing.

A player would be better off hitting hundreds of partial swings with sand wedges on, varying the distances, along with chipping and putting, than worrying about the Big #1 so much. The driver will come around if other clubs are consistent.



As an instructor for 30 years, I see the most improvement and consistency in players who follow the above plan. Players who come to the practice range with only a driver seem to not improve as much. Many players can get caught up in the hype and advertisements of the latest technology in new drivers. If you want to improve, have a Professional look at your game, and spend 50% of your practice time chipping and putting. It is said that roughly 55% of your score occurs within 20 yards of the green. Whenever Tour players are asked why they didn't win this week, most say their "short game" wasn't as sharp, pointing directly at their chipping and putting.
