WELL PROJECT AT LONE TREE GOLF COURSE COMPLETE

Lone Tree Golf Club & Hotel uses non-potable, untreated well water to irrigate the course. Last summer, the well that is located on hole #5 along Lone Tree Parkway (just south of Timberline Drive) failed. This spring, crews drilled a new 1,800-foot deep well to ensure there is adequate water to maintain turf on the course. Staff appreciates the community's patience throughout the process.



RECENTLY COMPLETED

Abbott Park: Renovations to Abbott Park included new sod. repaired drinking fountains and new LED shelter lights. A public celebration was held at the modern-themed playground that included a scavenger hunt, snacks, and giveaways.

Little Dry Creek Park: A new post-tension basketball court and modern-themed playground highlight the renovations at Little Dry Creek Park. Sod was installed and a public celebration was held on June 17.

Writers Vista: A new restroom and shade pavilion were installed to improve accessibility and meet the unique needs of park and trail users. Colorado Journey Miniature Golf Improvements: Both courses opened for play this summer after major renovations to the facility. Patrons can appreciate a new PA system and new turf all 36 holes. Crews installed new water pumps and installed a few new fun features.




