BOOKTHE SOUTH PLATTE EXPRESS

10 - 12 youth guided at the table, with a second naturalist leading activities for a similar sized group at the same time. Demonstrations can run back to back for multiple classrooms or grades on one day.

Activities can include live crayfish encounters, animal classification, life cycles, habitats, adaptations, pelts and skulls, open-space/schoolyard exploration, and more.

Rental Fees

Delivery and Setup: \$129/\$139 Programming: \$118/\$130 per hour, 1 hr min. Transport outside the South Suburban District and greater than 30 minutes may have additional transport fees. Scholarship funds may be available.

Express can be used in an open meadow, playground or parking lot. It can be rolled into a building to a science or art classroom, cafeteria, gymnasium, wide hallway, or garage.

Site requirements: Access to 65 gallons of water (spigot, hose, or sink), location to drain or to empty water.

Indoor requirements: 40" doorway (most schools have double doorways with removal center mullion/columns), paved unload area and route/ramp/lift that meets ADA standards. 110 power helpful for long demonstrations but not required. Table can remain locked on site for multiple days of activities.

Outdoor requirements: firm, level location. Shade or windblock for weather. Can run via onboard battery.

Activities can be adapted from Kindergarten through middle and high school, for general interest community groups or for focused river-dynamics adult studies.

Table uses chlorine sanitation and disinfecting of all touch points.
